Dear Parent/Carers

We are now on our countdown to the Year 6 Residential Trip to Stubbers Adventure Centre which takes place from Monday 22nd May to Friday 26th May.

We decided that a letter relating to the next stage may be more beneficial to you rather than another meeting, which many parents find difficult to attend.

Medical Form

Stubbers require details of the children's medical, dietary and special needs. Could you please fill in the attached medical and dietary form and return it to the School by no later than **Friday 5th May 2017**.

We **must** have your child's medical NHS number. If you do not have a record of this, it can be obtained from your Doctors Surgery. This number is required to avoid any delays should there be any form of medical emergency.

Any medicines should be clearly labelled, this includes Paracetamol as the teachers will supervise its administration. It should **not** be kept in children's luggage. Medicines can be handed into school the week before the trip, or if not brought on the day.

It should be noted that a large amount of time is spent in fields, therefore could all Hayfever sufferers please be provided with any relevant medication.

Kit List

We also enclose an up to date kit list which we have found over the years contains all the essentials. Clothing can get very dirty so we do not recommend expensive or brand new clothing is packed for the children.

The wet shoes are essential or alternatively an old pair of trainers which can be worn in water, as all water activities require the wearing of footwear.

Can we ask that you please label towels as children often do not recognise their own!

Mobile Phones/Cameras

Please do not allow your child to pack a mobile phone. The staff have phones with them at all times as well as parent contact numbers. They are also in constant contact with the school.





The children are welcome to bring cameras, although I would stress nothing expensive please! The staff themselves take copious pictures which will be available to you (free of charge) once they return from the trip.

Finally, the children do not require any money as there is nothing to buy; ice-creams etc. are generally purchased by the staff.
