Community Governor Vacancy

From November 2015, Jotmans Hall Primary School's Governing Body will have a vacancy for a Community Governor. This is a voluntary position. The Governing Body is made up of 15 Governors; these include 5 Staff Governors, 3 Parent Governors and 7 Community Governors. The Full Governing Body meets 4 times a year and the Sub Committees meet termly.

As an Academy School, Jotmans Hall is registered with Companies House and as such all Governors would be recorded with Companies House as a Director of Jotmans Hall Primary School.

Governors play an important role as members of the Governing Body, which is responsible for directing the conduct of the School and for promoting high standards of educational achievement. The term of office for Community Governors, as determined by the Governing Body, is 4 years. Training is available for all Governors and those new to being a Governor are encouraged to attend induction training.
