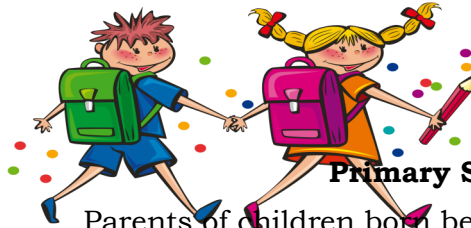

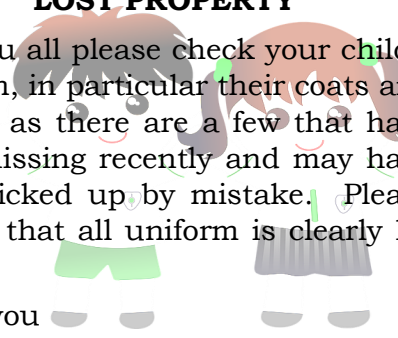
### D & T AFTERNOON
