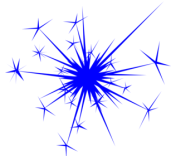


### **BOOK FAIR**

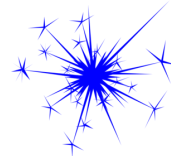
*Message from T Sullivan....*

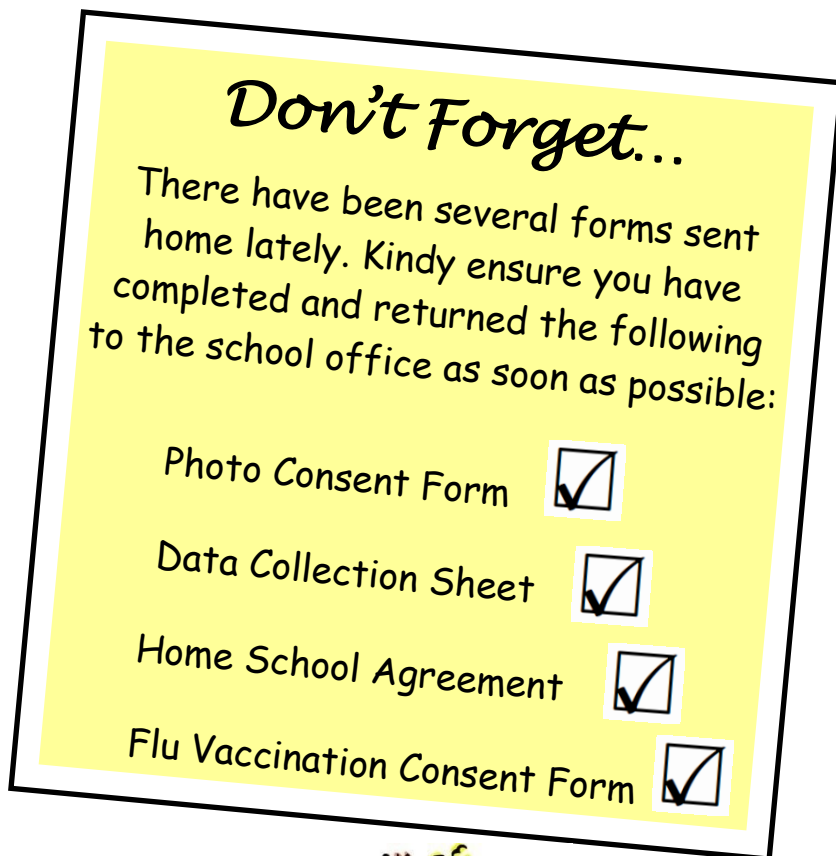
The Royal Society of the Prevention of Accidents Website, has lots of information and guidelines, to help keep everyone safe and make Bonfire Night fun for everyone.
